

AUCTION GUIDELINES

When you checked in this evening, you were assigned a **BIDDER NUMBER** and given a **BIDDING PADDLE.** Keep your paddle with you, and remember your bidder number.

SILENT AUCTION (6:30pm - 9:30pm)

- Browse the Silent Auction in the **Skylight Room** near the bar throughout the evening.
- To bid on an item, write down your bid on the corresponding bid sheet.
 Be sure to include your bidder number, initials, and bid amount, and follow the bidding increment noted on the bid sheet.
- **Check back regularly** to see if you have been outbid, and to enter a new bid on the items you are interested in.
- When the Silent Auction closes at 9:30pm, a staff member will collect the bid sheets and post the name of the winner on the sign for each item.

LIVE AUCTION (8:15pm)

- When the program begins, ensure you have your bidding paddle, and take a seat in the **Garden Room**.
- To bid on an item being offered, **raise your paddle** so that the number is clearly visible to the auctionner and auction spotters. Leave your paddle raised until the auctioneer acknowledges your bid.

#5: "My Work" by Joan Snyder

(Starting Bid: \$1800)

Size: 22.25 x 25 in; Medium: Etching and woodcut on paper; Type: Print; Creation Date: 1997. Joan Snyder has been called an autobiographical, even confessional artist, who draws from her experiences and surroundings to create her paintings. While her subjects vary widely, Snyder has developed a signature style in her work over the past 40 years, characterized by gestural, patchy brushwork and vivid color combinations. She has also mixed unconventional materials into her paint, including silk, burlap, seeds, twigs, dirt, and glitter. In spite of studying Minimalism with Robert Morris, Snyder found herself tending towards expressionism, saying: "I wanted my paintings to have more content, not less. I wanted to be a maximalist, not a minimalist." She was more inspired by the Russian and German Expressionists; in fact, Aleksej von Jawlensky's portraits were instrumental in convincing Snyder to pursue her painting career. Snyder was awarded a MacArthur Fellowship in 2008.

#11: "Pat Sabatine's Eighth Birthday Party" by Larry Fink

(Starting Bid: \$1100)

Size: 8.5 x 11; Creation Date: April 1977 Signed Digital Archival Print. One of Larry Fink's most iconic photographs, featured in his book, "Social Graces." Mr. Fink documented the everyday lives of his neighbors in rural Pennsylvania in photos like "Pat Sabatine's 8th Birthday Party" (1977). "Social Graces" placed Mr. Fink firmly in the photographic canon. It drew comparisons to the street photos of Weegee and Diane Arbus and even to the paintings of Caravaggio. (Mr. Fink was a master of shadow and light.) When the pictures were shown in 2001 at the Yancey Richardson gallery in Manhattan's Chelsea section, Ken Johnson, writing in The New York Times, described them as "wonderfully absorbing, funny, skewed, ethereally glowing documents of human situations." He added, "Every picture is like a good short story — here John Cheever, there Raymond Carver." His black-and-white images captured the chilly anomie of Manhattan's haute monde, the strangeness of Hollywood royalty and the lively warmth of rural America.
